VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

AT NIWRA, we couldn't operate without our amazing volunteers. All roles are essential to our operation and ability to educate the public on wildlife and environmental issues.

Please check the square boxes that interest you.

- Education Volunteer - Ask Me Ambassador:** Have fun while you mingle with our visitors and share information on our work and non-releasable resident animals. Training and mentoring will be provided. The minimum time commitment is one *4-hour shift per week*.
- DAN'S NOOK WILDLIFE GARDEN:** This position involves caring for the garden's well-being (watering, weeding, tidying) and greeting garden visitors. It is a rewarding position that is perfect for those with a green thumb and those who want to learn. The minimum time commitment is one *4-hour shift per week*.
- GROUNDS & YARD VOLUNTEER:** Help our yard crew look after our meticulously manicured grounds. This position is perfect for someone who enjoys working outside (mowing lawns, clean-up, raking, trimming, etc.). The minimum time commitment is a 3-4 hour *shift per week*.
- GIFT SHOP VOLUNTEER:** Located in the main building, this position is the first contact with our visitors. You will be trained to operate our point of sale system, perform merchandising duties and answer general inquiries in person and over the telephone. The minimum time commitment is one *4-hour shift per week*.
- ANIMAL TRANSPORT:** We are always looking for volunteers to transport animals between other locations and our facility. This position is on an **as-needed** basis.
- ANIMAL CARE:** Volunteers who work in our animal care department can perform a variety of tasks to care for our animals and enclosures on an as-needed basis. They are often chosen from experienced education volunteers who have demonstrated a commitment to our programs and have logged hours being trained and mentored by our staff. The minimum time commitment is one *4-hour shift per week*.
